In its 18th year, the **“Fore Our Schools” Golf Tournament** provides an opportunity for the community to partner with the Foundation and fund programs to support students and teachers of Orange County Public Schools. Since the first tournament in 1999, it has netted over \$2.1 million.

The tournament uses two award-winning Jack Nicklaus - designed courses at Grand Cypress. Contests include hole-in-one, longest drive, closest to the pin and putting ... along with a premier raffle/silent auction and giveaways. This tournament provides a great opportunity to meet and network with School Board members, district leadership and other community businessmen/women while investing in the education of our future leaders.

All players receive a round of golf, breakfast, lunch, swag bag, a day of fun and more!

### Impact Snapshot

The Foundation serves as the district’s philanthropic arm. Sharing the district’s goal of accelerating student success, the Foundation responsibly raises, manages and distributes donors’ gifts. Some of those gifts funded the following programs:

**Read2Succeed** - provides individualized reading instruction to 400 first-grade, 600 second-grade and 160 third/fourth-grade students at 75 elementary schools.

**Teacher Grants** - awarded more than \$200,000 in classroom grants for STEM, civics, fine arts, non-fiction classroom libraries, and technology to 361 teachers, positively impacting more than 28,000 students, for equipment and materials that directly impact classroom learning.



Partially funded by a Duke Energy STEM Grant, Timber Creek High School’s BANGARANG Team won the 2015 VEX Robotics State Championship.

**CHILL (Community Health and Intervention in Life’s Lesson) Program** - provided a licensed or licensed-eligible mental health counselor to the elementary and middle schools that feed into Winter Park High School. CHILL counselors offered individual, group and family counseling services with parent consent.

- 1,798 students were screened and,
- over 1,113 entered into the program

**School & District Funds** - The Foundation manages more than 35 school and 25 district funds to help schools build their capacity and district programs to serve unmet needs. These funds raised \$865,566 during the 2015-16 fiscal year.

### Grant Spotlight - Timber Creek High Jennifer Kane, Engineering

#### Using Robots to Repair the STEM Pipeline

During this project, two teams of students applied the knowledge and skills learned in their Project Lead The Way engineering classes to create robots and compete with other students in the VEX Robotics Competition. This year’s game was called “Nothing But Net.” Our students learned the importance of being able to adapt, strategize, and learn from their experiences. The robotics team students have become role models to the other students in class by sharing and demonstrating what they have learned throughout the season and by helping beginning students learn the basics of robotics.
